#### CREATING A LESSON PLAN: 4 hours credit

- Writing the Lesson Plan using vocabulary words frequently used by instructors.
- Review/Editing/Evaluating the Lesson Plan for understanding according to the MVA curriculum.
- Writing the Final Lesson Plan.

- Writing the Final Route Plan to include all 3 route plans.
